Winter Park Wrap-up

We had a great 3 days of skiing on our late season trip to Winter Park, CO. We had 42 people on this one and everything went smoothly. The bus picked us up in Green Bay, Appleton and Fond du Lac, and took us to Milwaukee Airport for our flight to Denver. We landed on time, got our bus to Winter Park, with obligatory stop at Applejacks and King Supers. We pulled into our condos at Beaver Village around 9 PM and checked in with enough time to get into town for a late dinner.

First day was a perfect day for skiing. Temperature was perfect high on the mountain, just a bit below freezing, no wind, partly sunny. It did warm up lower on the mountain and did get a bit slushy in the late afternoon, but it was nice to get some sun on the deck at the Derailer Bar.

Overnight we got a bit of snow, more on the upper mountain. We had a lunch set up at 1 PM at the Snoasis with barbecue sandwiches, potato salad, lettuce salad and brownies. A few people were late as they opened The Cirque off-piste ski area on top of the mountain at noon, and they just had to get a run in.

On Tuesday, our last ski day, more snow overnight, but clearing by the times the lifts opened. It snowed on and off lightly until late afternoon, when it really started coming down. Our last get-together was that evening at the common room at Beaver Village. It was a BYOB leftover party, with a few pizzas delivered to round it out. We did the departure drill, 5 am departure the next morning, then it was on to the Lunar Award Nominations.

Notable nominations were Tom V.B. who tried to spray GF Lori with snow. You know how this one goes, ski up to friends and do a big hockey-stop in front of them and shower them in snow. But this one was a classic fail when his skis skidded out on him, dumping him in front of Lori, standing on her snowboard and shaking her head. We heard back from them that they eventually made it home to Green Bay that evening.

So that is the end of the Sly Fox 2017 ski season. Now we start planning for next year.
