FRIENDS OF FOXES REWARDS program benefits the existing members and builds the membership of our club with new members for the enjoyment and benefits of organized group rate discount ski trips, other club sponsored functions and most of all the camaraderie.

"FRIENDS OF FOXES REWARDS" awards present Sly Fox Ski Club Members with 10 points (or \$10 towards Sly Fox Ski Club sponsored functions) for all New Members they referred, when they join the club.

To receive FOX POINTS, the New Member must document the referring member on their Membership Form when joining the club.

The FOX POINTS can accumulate during the one ski season that they have been earned and can be used towards club trips, the renewal of their present membership dues, Spring and Christmas Holiday banquets.

The FOX POINTS must be used by the end of the season on or before April 30th and cannot be carried over to the following year.

The New Member joining the club may not be a past member of the club within the last 4 years or a renewing member.

FOX POINTS are not transferable to another member.

The new and present members must be a minimum of 21 years of age.

The FOX POINTS will be documented by the Treasurer when the New Membership Form with payment is received.

NOTE: At this time, we are still waiting for airline tickets to become available. We estimate additional cost of tickets plus motorcoach transportation to Milwaukee or O'Hare of \$550. Nonstop flight to SLC.

Lift Tickets – not included.

Purchased at skigroup.net after registered for trip.

Since Park City is an Epic Pass resort, lift tickets are on your own and should be purchased by you separately after you sign up. Since prices will go up over time, buy early and save. You should buy these directly on-line from Skigroup.net to get bonus pricing, such as a \$50 discount when you buy (5 day minimum)

Tickets are available as 1 to 6 day Epic day passes at about \$120 per day. Note that since our first day to ski, Sunday, Feb 15, is restricted because it is Presidents Day blackout period and it will cost more to ski on Sunday.

If you are looking to ski at other Epic Resorts, such as Gelandesprung Telluride trip, or possible late season Sly Fox trip to Crested Butte, you may consider buying a full Season Epic Pass, currently \$1075. This pass has no Blackout dates.
