

Indianhead Mountain Ski Resort

Indianhead Mountain near Wakefield, Michigan, was developed by a Chicago pilot, Jack English, who flew over the area during the 1950s, looked down at the abundant snow and the suitable terrain, and decided it would be a great place to build a ski resort. Other ski resorts would follow, helping the Upper Peninsula's economy to recover from the failing iron mines.

I remember the long lift lines at the popular resort, and the second parking lot was usually full on weekends. Then in the 1980s and '90s Indianhead fell on hard times and was eventually sold at a bankruptcy auction in 2000. New owners reinvested in the business and kept it going.

I began skiing at Indianhead in the early 1960s. A friend from work invited me to come with her and husband. Marian eventually dropped me as a ski partner. Why? First, I suggested we do one more run before going in for lunch at the Indianhead cafeteria. She ended up in a "yard sale" near the bottom of "Voyageur's Highway" resulting in a broken leg. Second, we did a subsequent trip to Snowmass, CO where she slid head first into a pine tree up on the Big Burn. A year later I suggested that we go back to Indianhead. She informed me that she had sold her skis.

Yet another person sold his skis after being hauled up the mountain by the Indianhead ski patrol. That was my late husband, Bob. With a broken collar bone, he decided he was in too much pain to join our small group of friends (including Roger and Lynn Van Vreede and Dan and Pat Griedl, present and former Sly Foxes respectively) for dinner. We brought him back a doggie bag of margaritas. He must have really been in pain, because he did not partake.

Lake-effect snowfall in the U.P. depends on many things: water temperatures of Lake Superior, the amount of ice coverage, wind directions and velocity, and topographical features near the Lake. It provides up to 50% of the snowfall at Indianhead and nearby ski areas.

I remember one particularly cold, windy and snowy weekend years ago. Friend and former Sly Fox member, Don Winrich, had invited a few of us up to his ski house *Tuckaway*. The weather forecast was for 45-degrees-below-zero wind chill. Everyone cancelled out; everyone, that is, except me...and Don. I left my ski jacket home and packed an even warmer parka with faux-fur hood. With my goggles and neck gaiter, there wasn't a bare spot on me; I was ready!

Don, with his brand new red/orange Salomon skis, heads over towards the black runs. The wind is blowing up the mountain; it feels at LEAST -45°. The snow is hard packed and slow; I can't make it up the little hill over to chairlift #3. "Weight makes haste," I think. Don makes it up the hill. Maybe it's his skis. It was then I decided to get a pair of skis just like Don's! I even ordered them a little longer than the pair Al Pachmayer (former owner of the "Ski Inn" in Neenah) let me take out to Colorado that spring. "Now," I thought, "I can keep up with Don!"

Our President Dar tells of a time when she and a few Sly Foxes including Gary Arnold, Erik Hansen and Roger Miller, skied Indianhead in late November. Only one run was open, so they skied down the left side of the run, then the middle and then the right. Then they reversed the order for some variety! Lift tickets were \$26, so they planned to make 26 runs...but got a bit bored by the 13th. "Well," they figured, "We got it down to \$2 a run!"

Former Sly Fox member Paul Carlson lives in Vilas County now (as do I) near the Michigan border. A few years ago I raced in the Wednesday afternoon adult league at Indianhead. Paul is still racing, and still getting golds! His significant other, Carrie Stiegler, brings home a few medals herself! She was

married to former Austrian skier Josef "Pepi" Stiegler who beat out two American skiers, Jimmie Heuga and Billie Kidd for a gold in the 1964 Winter Olympics in Innsbruck. In 1965 Pepi came to Jackson Hole, Wyoming, where he developed the ski school there that he ran for 37 years. Pepi and Carrie had two children, both presently on the U.S. ski team.

Many top NASTAR racers compete at Indianhead. So do a few snow bunnies! See you at Indianhead on January 11?


The FOX POINTS must be used by the end of the season on or before April 30th and cannot be carried over to the following year.




