Officer Positions of Sly Fox Ski Club

Coordinate the contacts for newsletter advertisers and report to the Board.

Coordinate with the club Committees as requested by the Board.

Treasurer duties shall be to:

Receive all organization funds and deposit them in the official financial institution.

Disburse all funds authorized by the Board and sign checks.

Maintain organization's financial accounts and records.

Make available the accounts and records for inspection by the President, Board of Directors or authorized auditors.

Make a financial report to the Board monthly, at the end of the year and at such times as requested by the President.
