Newsletter Editorial




The FOX POINTS must be used by the end of the season on or before April 30th and cannot be carried over to the following year.

Full Trip Price:	\$3160, all prices are double occupancy.
Deduct Barcelona:	\$350, You will need to provide your own transportation from Chicago O'Hare airport.
Deduct Air:	\$960, Your own air transportation to Geneva and from Barcelona
Deduct O'hare bus:	\$50
Deviations:	\$150, charge for alternate itineraries (stay-overs, alternate airports) plus any added airfare, only available before December 1, 2022.
Add Single Sup. Meribel:	\$1000, Limited availability
Add Single Sup. Barcelona:	\$250

Trip is open for signup on June 15, 2022. Initial deposit of \$600 required. Second payment of \$1000 is due October 5, 2022. Final balance is due November 16, 2022. Cancellation fees are as follows:

\$600 from October 12 to November 23, 2022

Full amount after November 23, 2022

While cancellation fees can be waived if a substitute can be found for the spot, there will be a minimum \$200 cancellation fee plus any costs associated with the change. After airline tickets are issued on December 15, they are non refundable less and non-changeable (no name changes allowed).

This trip has been priced at an exchange rate of 1.00 Euro = \$1.10US. While there is a contingency allowance built in to the trip, any extreme change in the rates could increase the cost of the trip which is the responsibility of the trip participants. If the exchange rate turns in our favor, added benefits will be included (parties, transport tickets, activities, etc).

Adequate insurance in case of accidents, skier mountain evacuation, emergency medical treatment, and evacuation home, delays including Covid quarantine costs and airline change fees and travel back to Appleton/Green Bay is recommended.

A valid passport is required, and should have an expiration date no earlier than August 7, 2023 (6 months validity beyond the trip completion date).

Due to the extra airline fees required for luggage of more than one checked item, and bus storage limitations, I STRONGLY recommend that you rent skis in Meribel and leave yours at home.

Membership in the Sly Fox Ski Club or the Gelandesprung Ski Club is a requirement to sign up.

International Travel in the Age of Covid

For people planning on registering for our 2023 Meribel, France and Barcelona, Spain trip, please read this and sign and send with your sign-up form. This information is as of today, May 27. Things may become less restrictive by the time the trip departs, or more restrictive if new variants cause a large increase in infections.

We are flying into Switzerland and there are currently no entry requirements. We are transferring to France on a charter bus, and there are health requirements to enter France. If you have a CDC vaccination certificate with a booster within 9 months of your 2nd shot, you are good to go. The vaccines must be mRNA type vaccines as approved by the EU, for US residents, that means either Pfizer or Moderna vaccines. If you do not have a valid vaccination certificate, you will need to provide proof of a negative PCR Covid test taken within 72 hours of departure.

We are flying into Spain, which has similar requirements as France. In addition, we may have to each fill out a form with vaccination or negative PCR Covid test information. The test may have to be performed while we are in France. On entry into Spain, that information will be entered into your smart phone as a QR code. So yes, everyone is going to have to have a smart phone on this trip.

Finally, in order to return to the United States, you will have to provide a negative PCR test within 72 hours of boarding the flight. We will try to arrange a group test in Barcelona, since everyone, regardless of vaccination status, has to provide this. This is a requirement of the United States government.

There are 3 important takeaways from all of this.

1. IT IS RECOMMENDED TO BE FULLY VACCINATED AND BOOSTED BEFORE GOING ON THE TRIP! IT WILL MAKE YOUR LIFE A WHOLE LOT EASIER. If you have a problem with this, you should really think twice about signing up for this trip.

- **You should** seek the guidance of your doctor or other qualified health professional with any questions you may have regarding covid vaccines.

2. HAVE A SMARTPHONE AND KEEP IT CHARGED! French and Spanish health authorities will give you QR codes to be loaded on your phone that will act as your vaccination passport.

3. HAVE ADEQUATE TRAVEL INSURANCE! If you do test positive while in Europe, it will cover a reasonable cost of living expenses and change fees for your flight home, and costs from O'Hare back to Appleton or Green Bay.

I have spoken with Myra Altschuler of Travel Protectors about travel insurance. Her company is again providing group Medevac policies. One change is that now, the price you pay will be based on your age. I will outline this on a separate page. Besides the Medevac policy, there are two other types of insurance available, traditional travel insurance, and Cancel-For-Any-Reason travel insurance. Cancel for any reason means exactly that, but it is a lot more expensive, and it only reimburses you for 75% of your trip cost, and it must be purchased within 3 weeks of your initial deposit and that means the date on your check.

Now regarding traditional travel insurance, if you were not vaccinated, and you tested positive before your flight departing for Europe and could not go, that would be a covered reason to cancel, and you would be reimbursed for your trip cost. Medevac would not cover that expense, since the trip had not started yet. Medevac will cover a set amount of living expenses while you quarantine in Europe and flight change fees if you test positive there.

Travel Insurance for International Travel

As was stated in the “International Travel in the Age of Covid” document, it is important to have adequate travel insurance for an overseas trip. We have worked in the past with Travel Protectors LLC for group Medevac Plans. They are offering this policy for trip members as long as we get 10 people to sign up. This is low cost and the minimum anyone should have to go on the trip. Myra Altschuler, the principle owner of Travel Protectors, will also offer regular comprehensive travel insurance on an individual basis. In addition, they are also offering Cancel-For-Any-Reason (CFAR) insurance. Insurance policies are underwritten by Crum & Forster Insurance. I will outline these below, as well as provide the contact information for Travel Protectors LLC.

Group Medevac Plan

Pricing is by age category. Prices are as follows:

Age 0-50	\$16
Age 51-60	\$22
Age 61-70	\$28
Age 71-80	\$37
Age 81 up	\$60

This policy provides emergency evacuation home in case of serious illness or injury, plus medical costs. In addition, in the case you test positive for Covid and must remain in quarantine in Europe until you test negative, up to \$750 of lodging and food costs, as well as up to \$500 in airline change fees.

Comprehensive Travel Insurance

In addition to the above, you can add on trip cancellation and trip interruption insurance, which will cover trip cancellation, before you leave home, for reasons such as physical illness, injury, testing positive for Covid and death to you, your travel companion/s or to an immediate family member, not traveling with you. Please contact Travel Protectors for a quote and more detailed coverage information.

Cancel For Any Reason Insurance (CFAR)

In addition to all of the above, you can cancel for any reason up to 48 hours before departure and receive 75% of your trip cost reimbursed. Please contact Travel Protectors for a quote and more detailed coverage information. **You must purchase this insurance within 21 days of the date written on your check for the initial trip deposit.**
