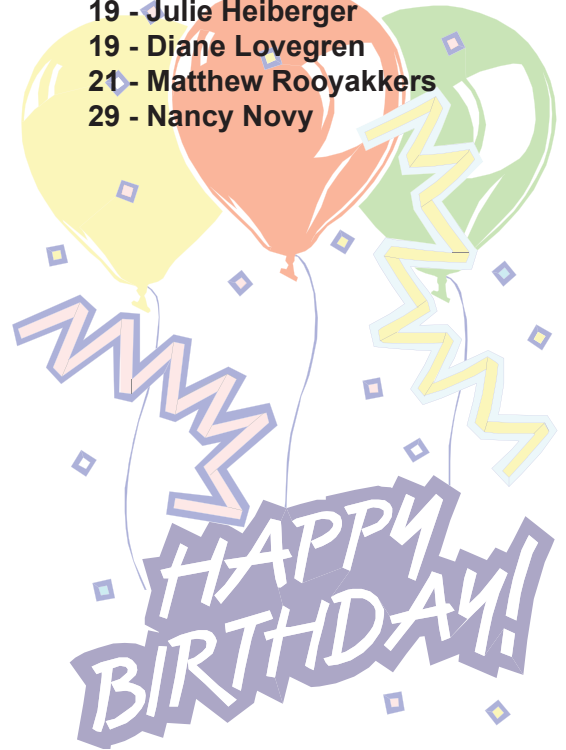

3. When you finish your shift, please return the bell to the bag. If another ringer doesn't come for the next shift or you're on the last shift of the day, leave your bell in the clear bell bag. You are free to leave when your shift is over.
 1. We pick up the kettles each night, so there's no need to worry about leaving the kettle unattended.
4. If you or your group are interested in singing Christmas carols or playing an instrument at the kettles instead of ringing bells, please call/text the Bell Office at (920) 570-1758.
