I'll just say a few words about Bill's time in the Sly Fox Ski Club. His first major trip that I recall was to Jackson, Wyoming in 2002. Bill rode the tram to the top and tackled the black diamond Rendezvous Bowl head on. In those days, Bill's chosen outfit was an old snowmobile suit. Five years later, Bill was sporting gray bumper pants with black knee patches and a slim parka looking about 50 years younger. Maybe that is why that year, at Breckenridge, Bill got a "speeding ticket" by the Yellowjacket safety patrol. Another trip participant, 22 year old expert Karen Weiler, also got one. So the oldest and youngest people on the trip got warnings to "slow down".

Bill took to racing Nastar at every opportunity. His medals (for his age bracket) earned him invitations to the Nastar National Tournament in Colorado, which he attended several times. Bill also did not pass on après ski activities either, always dancing with the youngest partner he could find. At Big Snow II in 2019, Bill skied for his last time at the age of 90. He was quite proud of that, and more or less said "Top that if you can!"
