The Spring Banquet is this Friday, May 2. I hope to see many of you there. It is always a fun evening.



# FRIENDS OF FOXES REWARDS 2025 - 2026

FRIENDS OF FOXES REWARDS program benefits the existing members and builds the membership of our club with new members for the enjoyment and benefits of organized group rate discount ski trips, other club sponsored functions and most of all the camaraderie.

"FRIENDS OF FOXES REWARDS" awards present Sly Fox Ski Club Members with 10 points (or \$10 towards Sly Fox Ski Club sponsored functions) for all New Members they referred, when they join the club.

To receive FOX POINTS, the New Member must document the referring member on their Membership Form when joining the club.

The FOX POINTS can accumulate during the one ski season that they have been earned and can be used towards club trips, the renewal of their present membership dues, Spring and Christmas Holiday banquets.

The FOX POINTS must be used by the end of the season on or before April 30th and cannot be carried over to the following year.

The New Member joining the club may not be a past member of the club within the last 4 years or a renewing member.

FOX POINTS are not transferable to another member.

The new and present members must be a minimum of 21 years of age.

The FOX POINTS will be documented by the Treasurer when the New Membership Form with payment is received.

## Copper Mountain Trip Report

Sly Fox Ski & Snowboard Club went to Copper Mountain, Colorado from March 30 to April 4. We were expecting warm, sunny spring skiing. What we got instead was 4 days of winter, with daily snow fall and freshies every morning of 4 days of skiing. We had 46 people on the trip.

We started very early on March 30 with a bus departure from The Woods in Green Bay at 12:45am, followed by the rest of the crew at Appleton pick up at 1:30 am. That got us to Milwaukee Airport at 3:45 am to check in for our 5:30 am flight to Denver. All told 39 people on the plane, which arrived on time and we met a couple more people who flew in from Florida the night before. Then it was off to Copper.





We met 5 more people who drove out at the hotel, which brought us to 46.

The Cambria Hotel is quite nice, with daily hot breakfast buffet included, its own restaurant, hot tubs, and walking distance to the lifts at Center Village, as well as the free buses to East Village and West Village. The group sampled various restaurants in the Center Village during the week, from Mexican to Asian, to Italian. And a few took the free Summit Stage bus to Frisco for dinner.

Apres Ski took place every day at Jack's at the Center Village base. Unfortunately, the live music was done for the season, but we enjoyed the fun of getting together after a day of skiing.

Oh yeah, the skiing! Fresh snow every day with tons of variety for everyone. A lot of our hard cores, and we had quite a few, were in the upper bowls. Some clicked off vertical like it was going out of style, with up to 37,000 vertical in a single day. Four great days of skiing.

So, with our 4 days wrapped up, we met at the Cambria Thursday evening for departure instructions and left over drinks and snacks.
